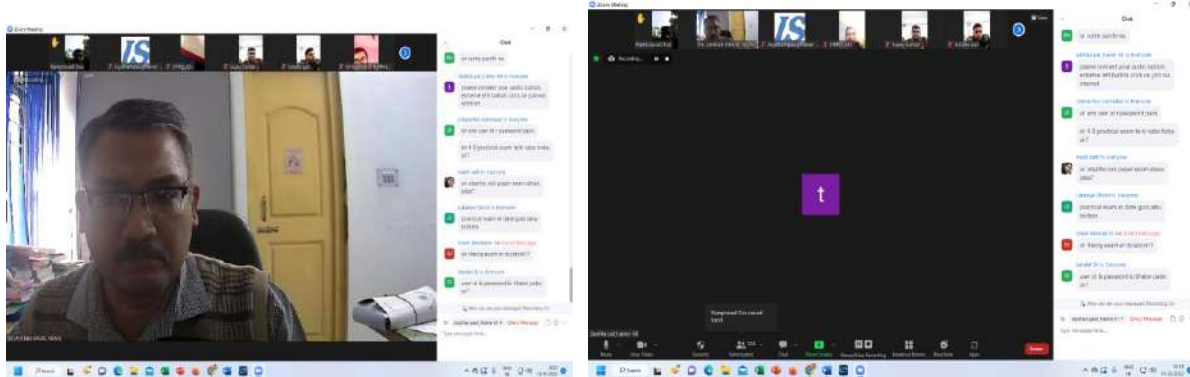
The sensitization programme was conducted to sensitize the students, enrolled under the School of Vocational Studies who are eligible for the Term-end Examination December 2022.

7. Applied Yoga & Naturopathy (Advanced Diploma)

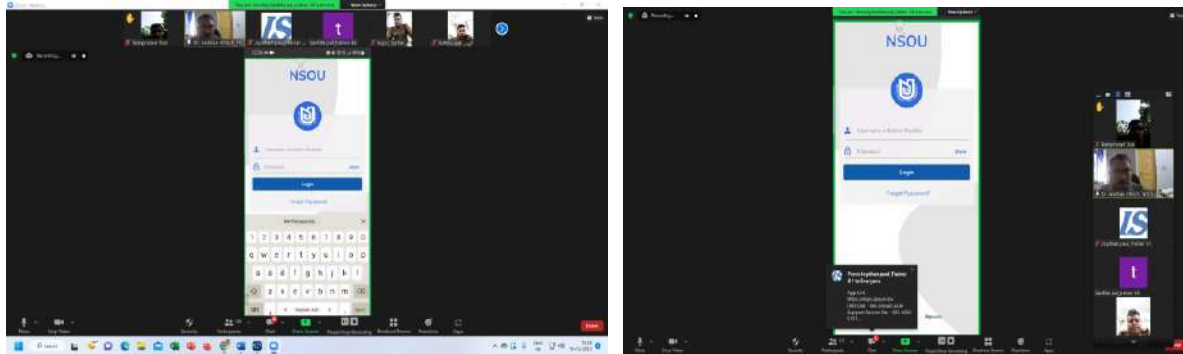


During the pandemic, the School conducted the term-end examination through digital platform. The process/system of examination has been discussed in detail and it was decided that the theory paper will be conducted through online (MCQ) to assess the domain knowledge of the students and the practical papers may be conducted on face to face mode to assess skills and competency in the specific trade by the respective study centres. The online examination (theory papers) will be conducted through LMS.

Papers	Mode of examination
Practical papers / project/ Viva	Traditional method (on campus) at the study centres
Theory papers	Online through LMS/ NSOU App (all examinees must have individual user ID and PW)

The admit card may be collected by the students from their respective Study Centre before the commencement of the examination.

The technical team demonstrated the process of examination to be followed step by step. They presented the entire process through mobile App.



Helpline for technical support was also provided (033 4058 5127) to the students. The programme ended with Q/A session where the doubts of the students were clarified by the experts.

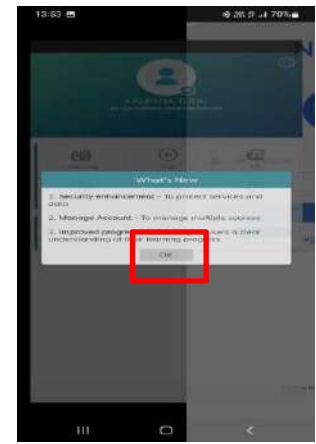

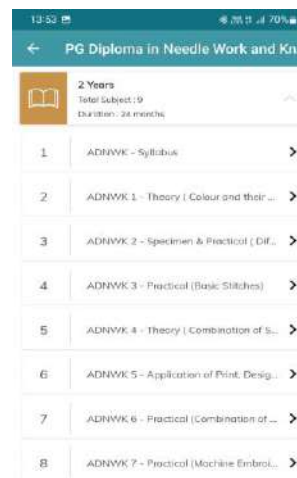

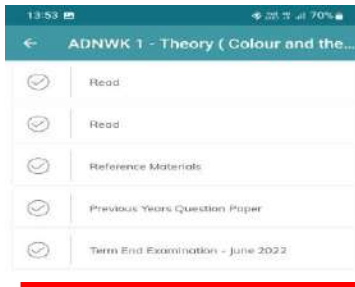
**NEW PAGE OPENS** with course Structure

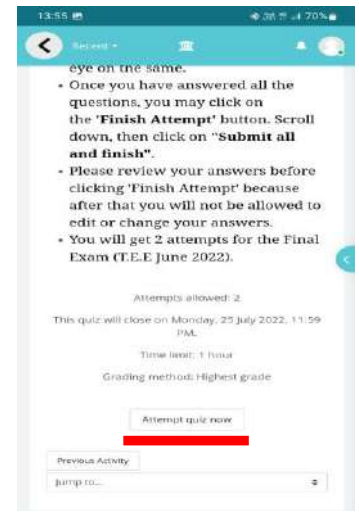
